An important way to do service! BTG volunteers ('Gappers') do AA service by meeting patients at A.A. meetings on the day of their release, introducing them to fellow members of Alcoholics Anonymous at the meeting, and sharing their experience, strength and hope. This may be the first AA contact a newcomer has ever had.
